## Fuel Line Kit 1954-1962 Pick Up Truck With 6-226 Super Hurricane Instructions

This fuel line kit is an exact reproduction of the original fuel line on 1954-1962 Pick Up Truck models with the 6-226 Super Hurricane engine. The kit has 3 steel lines (line from the carburetor to the fuel pump, main line from the front to the back and the little line that attaches the main line to the fuel tank), 90 degree brass fitting, fuel flexible line and seven clips to hold the line to the frame. The following pictures will show where the line is routed in the frame and where the clips are located.

The long main line will have to be straightened out at the marked areas. It then runs along the outside of the frame in the front and crosses to the inside after the front bed leg. Before the fuel tank the 90 degree fitting will be installed and the short line goes to the top of the fuel tank. The flexible fuel line will go from the main line in the front to the fuel pump. And the medium size line will go from the outlet on the fuel pump to the carburetor. Each of the pointed out clips will go in a factory 5/16" hole in the frame.
